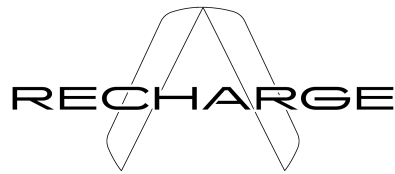

- **Protecting our workplace culture** by recognizing and supporting team goals and building positive relationships with team members.

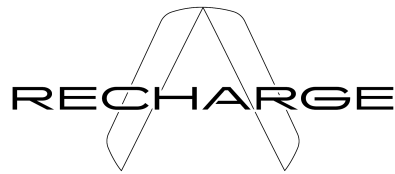
What it takes to Succeed:

- **Thirsty for knowledge**, seeking continuing education to build on their modality mastery (which must include Swedish and deep tissue massage).
- **Clear communicators** who can effectively identify each client's needs, set clear expectations, and stay connected to the client throughout the session to achieve the goals of each service.
- **Total body care champions** who can recommend follow-up visits and additional services and products as needed to help clients pursue their wellness goals.

Major Task and Responsibilities:

- Ensures the ADAPT RECOVERY experience for clients by maintaining the standards set by ADAPT RECOVERY's Mission Statement / Values, Standards and Expectations.
- Adheres to the policies of ADAPT RECOVERY.
- Performs massage and body services that meet the established guidelines for the type of service offering and that fulfill client expectations.
- Performs all treatments on services menu based upon current licensure.
- Assesses contraindications of clients that may prevent service from taking place.
- Meets the needs of the clients at all times throughout the service.
- Understands and uses universal precautions when providing services.
- Cleans and disinfects all equipment on a daily basis.
- Maintains the highest level of product knowledge and has complete knowledge of all ADAPT RECOVERY services presently offered. Understands the ingredients in products and can explain their benefits to clients.
- Answers clients' questions in a knowledgeable and professional manner.
- Recommends products for home use.
- Suggests to clients other beneficial treatments offered at ADAPT RECOVERY.
- Begins and ends all treatments on time.
- Works assigned schedule and arrives and departs from their shift on time.

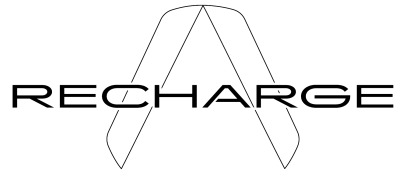


- Informs Director of ADAPT RECOVERY or other management personnel about product needs.
- Creates and maintains client cards and treatment notes, when appropriate.
- Completes all assigned side work.
- Attends all scheduled meetings (i.e. ADAPT Team Meeting, ADAPT RECOVERY Meeting, etc.).
- Attends scheduled professional training.
- Reports any incidents or accidents to a member of the management team.
- Other duties as assigned.

Qualifications & Essential Job Requirements:

- High School Diploma or GED.
- Valid state license in massage therapy or other credentials required by the state.
- Active professional liability insurance coverage.
- Previous massage and body work experience.
- Customer service experience, preferably in a spa.
- Must be able to build rapport with guests.
- Ability to explain various treatments / services to guests.
- Excellent customer service skills and work ethic.
- Efficient, well organized, and able to handle a variety of duties simultaneously.
- Energetic, enthusiastic, and motivational.
- Professional manner, discretion, and appearance.
- Good verbal and written skills.
- Strong team player.
- A comfort level with product recommendation.
- Availability When Facility Is Open: This could include nights, weekends, and holidays.
- Ability to stand for long periods.
- Medium Work: Exerting up to 50 pounds of force occasionally, and / or 20 pounds of force frequently, and / or up to 10 pounds constantly to move objects.
- This position requires the following abilities: balancing, kneeling, crouching, reaching, standing, walking, pushing, pulling, lifting, fingering, grasping, tactile sense, repetitive motions, seeing, hearing, talking, and visual acuity.
- The employee will be required to operate the following tools but not limited to: massage oils and lotions, hot stones, hot cabbie/hydrocollator, hand towels, body treatment products, hot packs, salts, and disinfectants.
- Work conditions include exposure to odors, fumes, and vibrations. For those working in a facility with a hot sauna/hammam, this would include working with water and steam in hot temperatures.
- Active NCCA Personal Training Certification (ACSM, ACE, NASM, NSCA) - strongly preferred but not a requirement.
